1. Background

The Eastern Cape Department of Education (ECDoE) is seeking the services of a specialist Service Provider in the field of coding and robotics to provide the Department from (Grade 7) Coding and Robotics Kits for 56 schools, three (3) kits per school. The kits must be delivered to Steve Vukile Tshwete Complex, Zwelitsha – Curriculum Management. The appointed Service Provider is expected to train the teachers on the use of the materials in the Kit.

This intervention forms part of the pilot project which the Department is embarking upon to pave the way for learners in this phase to prepare them to meet the demands of the world technology, which is now focusing more on coding, programming and artificial intelligence.

2. The kit for grade 7 must focus on class activity in that, assembly is in seconds-integration with 4th industrial revolution elements (3d printing & IoT)
